ISI's Moral Conduct Policy

International Students, Inc. (ISI) is an evangelical, Christian mission organization. ISI, as an organization, believes that the Holy Bible is the inerrant Word of God. In order to remain consistent with its mission, religious beliefs, and commitment to adhering to the Word of God, which is important to those ISI serves and those who contribute to it, ISI requires that all of its team members conduct themselves in a high moral and ethical manner according to scripture. This relates to conduct both on and off the "job."

ISI's interpretation of the Holy Bible is made by the leadership of ISI. Any individual who feels he/she has knowledge of another's failure in an area of moral or ethical conduct should follow the restoration process discussed in Matthew 18. Additionally, he/she should communicate with the individual's supervisor, as appropriate. The goal is always love and redemption. The circle of knowledge should be kept as small as possible with only those involved who are necessary for a solution.
