Internship may encompass the following:

- Learning how local teams create a ministry plan that complements the ISI National Ministry Plan
- Experiencing, establishing, and building relationships with international students, sharing Christ's love with them
- Gaining understanding of how ISI staff develop student leaders and disciple believing international students, preparing them for ministry in their homelands
- Discovering the value of Incorporating volunteers into ministry and developing partnerships with churches/pastors

- Understanding the importance of developing and maintaining positive relationships with university administrators/faculty
- Learning how ministries finance operations through proven fundraising methods.

By participating in activities such as:

- Completing various ISI training modules such as Exploring ISI, Partnership Development Training, REACH International Students, and M28 Global Discipleship Training
- Studying recommended books/videos
- Accompanying team members on one-to-one and group meetings/activities with international students
- Observing the screening, training process, and matching of Friendship Partners with international students
- Other duties as assigned.
